In mid December, despite an early blast of winter, we were able to deliver food hampers that included a turkey to approximately 260 families in the areas of the HRM that we regularly visit. Those locations include the 500 Block of Herring Cove Road, Bayers Westwood, Mulgrave Park, Greystone Drive and the former Scotia Court area in Dartmouth.
